

SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA MG CLUB'S DRIVE THROUGH RANCHO PALOS VERDES

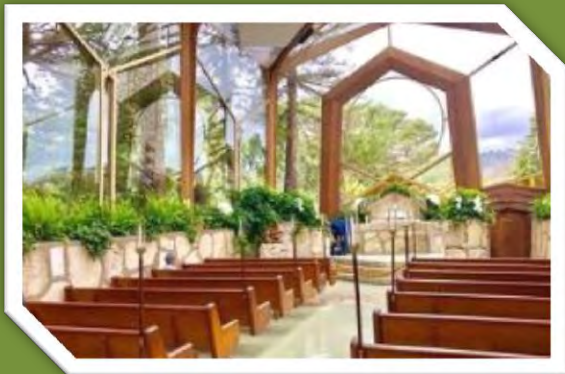
Rescheduled to Saturday, April 13, 2019 at 9:00 a.m.
